Our Associations provide information and communication for Ex Service Personnel who are eligible for, and granted, or in receipt of, the Totally & Permanently Incapacitated Compensation (TPI's) or Special Rate (SR) compensation payments referred to in Section 24 of the Veterans Entitlements Act (VEA) 1986 (as amended) or the Military Rehabilitation Compensation Act (MRCA) 2004 as determined by the Department for Veterans Affairs.

The TPI Federation is a strong voice for all TPI/SRs on a National and State/Territory basis. The Associations provide information and points of contact for our Members and for those who may wish to join our ranks.

All applications are welcomed for ordinary membership from any ex ADF person holding a current DVA Gold Card embossed with 'TPI'. Associate membership is available in some States/Territory.

We are represented on various National and State bodies including the Veterans' Advisory Council (VAC), Open Arms, and a variety of DVA Consultative forums. Outcomes of these meeting are disseminated to Members regularly along with other regular information updates.
