Bereavement Payments, Funeral Benefits and Other Assistance Under the VEA

Upon the death of a loved one, veteran families, executors or other responsible persons are asked to call the Veterans Access Network on 1800 VETERAN (1800 838 372) or email Bereavement. SA@dva.gov.au.

Bereavement Payment

- A one-off non-taxable payment to assist with additional costs following the death of eligible veterans.
- You do not need to apply if the deceased person was a member of a couple. Payment will occur automatically upon notification of the death to DVA.
- If the veteran was single, payment may be made to the estate. You need to make an application within 12 months of the veteran's death via Form D9145

Funeral Benefit

- A one-off payment up to a maximum of \$2000 to help with funeral costs of an eligible veteran or dependant.
- Veterans who are automatically entitled do not need to apply (TPI, EDA, Disability Compensation Payment plus an allowance as a multiple amputee, Veterans who were former prisoners of war).
- Other veterans who may be eligible will need the estate or dependant to submit an application within 12 months of the veteran's death.
- A funeral benefit is not payable under the VEA if the entitlement to a funeral benefit comes under MRCA.
- To apply for a funeral benefit, complete the Form <u>D0307 Claim for funeral benefit</u> and email to <u>DVA at bereavement.sa@dva.gov.au</u> or post to

Official Commemoration

Official commemoration recognises the service of eligible veterans or serving members after their death. This takes the form of a personalised, physical marker, such as a plaque. The marker can be at a site they or their family have chosen.

- Once DVA is notified of the veteran's death, and the veteran is eligible, the Office of Australian War Graves (OAWG) will notify the NOK and send a form to complete.
- If the veteran is found to not be eligible, you
 can request for it to be investigated by emailing
 compensation.claims@dva.gov.au or write to the
 Deputy Commissioner, Department of Veterans'
 Affairs, GPO Box 9998, Brisbane QLD 4001.
- You can call DVA on 1800 VETERAN (1800 838 372) to talk about your own eligibility, the eligibility of a family member or to tell DVA a death has occurred.
- You can also email <u>wargraves@dva.gov.au</u> if you have specific questions about the types of commemorations available.

The CVC Program is a proactive coordinated care program for DVA Gold Card holders who have a chronic health condition and/or are at a risk of unplanned hospitalisation. It aims to improve participant quality of life and decrease the risk of unplanned hospitalisation.

The participant, their GP and a nurse coordinator work as a team to develop a care plan to meet the health needs of the participant and manage the participant's ongoing care. NSW Country Taxi Voucher Scheme

This scheme does not operate in the metropolitan areas of Sydney, Canberra or Wollongong, or for travel across the borders into Victoria and Queensland.

OANTAS CONCESSIONS

For Qantas domestic travel within Australia, customers who require a carer to travel are eligible for a reduced fare for both themselves and their carer. These can only be booked through Qantas Contact Centres by calling 13 13 13. The following conditions apply.

When a Carer is Required

In certain circumstances, Qantas requires an escort or carer to accompany customers who are unable to care for themselves during a flight.

An escort or carer may be needed if:

- The passenger is unable to self-toilet.
- The passenger needs or wants to eat and drink during the course of the flight but is unable to do so without assistance.
- The passenger will require medication during the flight but is unable to administer it themselves.
- The number of passengers in a group travelling with an escort or carer exceeds Qantas Group cabin crew limits.

Requirements for Carers

The escort or carer must be self-reliant, and mentally and physically able to assist the passenger with the following if required:

- toilet and sanitary requirements both on the aircraft and on the ground
- inflight and ground emergencies
- carriage of carry-on baggage and/or equipment
- · medicating and medical procedure
- food and beverage consumption
- immigration and customs procedures.
- boarding and disembarkation

Documentation Required

To be eligible, the following documentation is required:

• a current Carer Concession photographic

- identification card issued by People with Disability Australia Incorporated (PWDA)
- a current Carer Concession photographic identification card issued by the National Information Communication Awareness Network (NICAN.
- a current Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card with blind entitlement; or
- a current travel pass for Person with Vision Impairment issued by a state or territory authority.

The Qantas Carer Concession Card was previously administered by NICAN, who ceased operation in July 2015. All current cards issued by NICAN will be honoured until they expire. Holders of expired NICAN issued Carer Concession Cards wishing to renew can do so with PWDA.

Pensioner Travel Vouchers

If you hold a NSW or ACT Pensioner Concession Card or a NSW Veteran Card marked war widow you are entitled to four Pensioner Travel Vouchers each calendar year for travel within regional NSW.

For your first booking, you will need to register your concession card with NSW TrainLink. You only

need to register your concession card once, and you can do this by calling 13 22 32.

Seniors Card Travel

If you have a Seniors Card issued by any Australian state or territory, you are entitled to concession fares on public transport in NSW. Some Seniors Cards are not accepted.

To be eligible for a Seniors Card you must be a NSW permanent resident aged 60 or over, doing no more than an average of 20 hours of paid work a week, across a 12 month period.

Ex-Members of the Defence Force Pass

War veterans who receive a Disability
Compensation Payment (DCP) under the Veterans'
Entitlements Act 1986 (VEA) and live permanently
in NSW, may be eligible for an Ex-Members of
the Defence Force pass. Veterans who have been
assessed at 10 impairment points or more linked to
warlike or non-warlike service under the Military,
Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004 (MRCA)
may also be eligible. This pass is also available
to certain Commonwealth and allied Second

World War veterans who live permanently in NSW. The pass, known as the Transport Concession Entitlement Card, entitles the holder to free travel on public transport in NSW.

If you are a DP (Disability Pension 70 -100%), EDA, INT, POW, TPI, OIP or TTI pension recipient you are eligible for a Veterans SmartRider card for free travel and parking for your registered vehicle. If you are a Wholly Dependent Partner, War Widow or War Widower who doesn't receive the Income Support

Supplement (ISS) you are eligible for a Veterans SmartRider card for concession travel.

As part of the application process, Transperth needs your consent to check with Centrelink or the Department of Veterans Affairs about your eligibility for a **Veterans SmartRider**.

Once Transperth has your consent, they can automatically confirm your eligibility every year.

You can apply in person at the Elizabeth Quay Bus Station InfoCentre on Mounts Bay Road, Perth. Please bring identification that verifies your entitlement. While you are there, your photo will be taken and your Veterans SmartRider card will be issued on the spot. VEHICLE CONCESSIONS

Disability Parking Permits

If you have a medical condition or disability that affects your mobility or vision, you may be eligible for a Mobility Parking Scheme (MPS) permit. The permit lets you park in disability parking spaces. You can also park at no charge and for longer time periods in some parking areas.

There are two types of permits issued by Transport for NSW (TfNSW):

- individual (blue card) issued for 5 years if you have a permanent disability
- temporary (red card) issued for up to 6 months if you have a temporary disability.

You may be eligible to apply for, replace or renew online if:

- · you have a photo exemption, or
- TfNSW has your photo on file (for example, driver licensed photo). The photo must have been taken within 10.5 years of when your new permit will expire.

GST Concession When You Buy or Lease a Car or Buy Car Parts

Claiming a GST concession

If you are a working person or veteran with a disability, you may be eligible to claim a goods and services tax (GST) car concession. To claim the concession, you will need to meet eligibility criteria. Eligibility criteria and the form to obtain the GST exemption can be found at https://www.ato.gov.au/forms-and-instructions/gst-free-car-disabled-veterans

GST car concessions apply to new or used cars. For GST purposes a car is a motor vehicle that can only carry:

- · a load less than one tonne
- less than nine passengers.

You may also be eligible to claim a concession for purchase of certain car parts.

Registration Concessions and Automatic Renewal for Pensioners

If you're an eligible pensioner, you may be exempt from some registration costs. Find out if you're eligible and how it works.

Eligibility

You're eligible for pensioner benefits if you're a NSW resident with a:

- current Pensioner Concession Card (PCC), issued by Services Australia (Centrelink) or the Department of Veterans' Affairs showing a NSW address
- Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold Card endorsed TPI (Totally and Permanently Incapacitated)
- Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold Card endorsed EDA (Extreme Disablement Adjustment)
- Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold Card endorsed War Widow
- statement from the Department of Veterans' Affairs stating that you:
- receive Disability Compensation Payment of 70% or higher
- receive an Intermediate or Extreme Disablement Adjustment pension, or
- have been assessed under the Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004, at 50 or more impairment points.

Service NSW checks your eligibility for concessions electronically. If your eligibility cannot be confirmed, you'll be sent a letter advising you to attend a service centre or call 13 22 13 to resolve the problem.

If you are not eligible, you'll be sent a renewal notice for the full private rate of registration. Interstate-issued pensioner concession cards Interstate-issued pensioner concession cards are not acceptable for claiming a concession in NSW.

Concessions and Benefits

Eligible pensioners do not have to pay:

- registration fees, including HVIS inspection fees
- motor vehicle tax
- conditional registration fees
- transfer fee and stamp duty for Department of Veterans' Affairs pensioners only who:
- receive a Disability Compensation Payment of 70% or higher

- receive an Intermediate, Totally and Permanently Incapacitated (TPI) or Extreme Disablement Adjustment (EDA) pension, or
- have been assessed under the Military Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004 at 50 or more impairment points.

The pensioner concession applies to one vehicle per eligible customer. If you have more than one vehicle, you must nominate the vehicle you want to receive registration concessions.

Automatic Pensioner Registration Renewal

Automatic pensioner registration renewal lets you skip the queue at renewal time. You won't need to visit a service centre, renew online or call us to process your registration.

You still need to buy compulsory third party (CTP) insurance and get a safety check for your vehicle when it's due (usually once a year). If no safety check is required, we use the first insurance policy we receive from you.

Automatic registration renewal can only be used on one vehicle per pension cardholder.

If your pensioner registration renewal notice shows zero cost and you have no restrictions on your vehicle or driver licence, we automatically renew your registration when we receive your:

- vehicle eSafety check
- CTP insurance policy.

If you have an online account with us, we'll send you an email or text message once your registration is renewed.

If you change to a pensioner registration within six weeks of your current registration's expiry date, it will not automatically renew. You need to visit a service centre in person to renew. After this, your registration will renew automatically each year.

Note: Automatic registration renewal is not available if a vehicle:

- has special number plates with fees payable
- is conditionally registered.
 Check your registration details online or call 13
 22 13 to change your details.

Cancelling Automatic Renewal

To opt out of the automatic renewal, contact us

before getting your next safety inspection report and CTP insurance renewal. Once you opt out, you need to visit a service centre in person to renew your registration.

Apply for an E-Toll Account Concession Introduction

If you're a concession card holder, you may be eligible for certain concessions on a new or existing E-Toll Account, including:

- account statements sent by post, free-of-charge
- reduced registration fees on an E-Toll Tagless Account
- exemption from the Sydney Harbour Bridge and Sydney Harbour Tunnel tolls (Totally and Permanently Incapacitated (TPI) DVA and drivers of modified vehicles with hand controls only).

You need to apply in person at a Service NSW Centre.

Eligibility

To be eligible, you must be the E-Toll Account holder and a holder of a:

- Centrelink pensioner concession card (PCC) or confirmation of concession card entitlement form (showing a NSW address), or
- Department of Veterans' Affairs DVA Gold Card endorsed with:
 - o TPI
 - o Extreme Disablement Adjustment (EDA), or
 - o War Widow/er.

Note: DVA Card holders that do not have TPI or EDA or War Widow/er embossing will need a DVA letter or statement/determination that states you:

- receive a disability pension of 70 percent or higher
- receive an Intermediate or Extreme Disablement Adjustment Pension, or
- have been assessed under the Military
 Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2004 at 50
 or more impairment points.

What you need

- proof of identity
- · your eligible concession card
- a copy of your registration papers showing the '87 condition' recorded against your vehicle (if you drive a modified vehicle with hand controls)

- your account number (if you already have an E-Toll Account), or
- · the E-Toll application form

How to apply

- · Check the eligibility requirements.
- Download and complete the E-Toll application form (if applicable).
- Gather your supporting documents and visit a service centre to lodge your application.
